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Translation of reservation policies (Page 15 – 16)

- 12. Reservation: Reservation policy of the Government of Madhya Pradesh, as follows -
- 12.1. 16 and 20 percent seats will be reserved for the applicants of Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) respectively. The locations of these two classes will be interchangeable.
- 12.2 14 percent seats will be reserved for applicants belonging to backward classes (except creamy layer).
- 12.3 Sons/daughters of freedom fighters and grandsons/granddaughters/granddaughters/ granddaughters of soldiers who have attained martyrdom or become permanently disabled in the line of duty in the Indian Army and dependents of former and serving army personnel (Defence personnel) 05 percent seats will be reserved jointly for the children of Central Armed Police Force and for the disabled category applicants of these categories. The combined merit of three classes should be determined by giving a surcharge of 10 percent marks to the applicants of the disabled category related to this, but this reservation will be made available only from the seats reserved for the respective cadre. The priority order of the personnel/officers of the Indian Armed Forces will be as follows:
- 1. Widow of a martyr during the war and their dependents.
- 2. Permanently disabled, serving soldiers and their dependents during the war.
- 3. Dependents of martyrs in service during peace.
- 4. Dependents of serving or ex-servicemen awarded the following gallantry medals -ParamVir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Best War Service Medal, MahaVir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, UttamSeva Medal, Vir Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, YudhSeva Medal, Army, Navy / Air Mention in Sena Medal Letters.
- 5. President's Police Medal for Gallantry, Police Medal for Gallantry
- 6. Dependents of Ex-Servicemen.
- 7. Dependents of serving soldiers.
- 12.4 5 percent seats will be reserved for the differently-abled category applicants, but this reservation will be made available only from the seats reserved for the concerned.

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cadre. Disabled will be given a relaxation of 5% in the qualifying marks at the time of admission.

- 12.5 NCC For applicants who have passed 'C' certificate, 1 percent of the sanctioned seats in the college will be reserved at the postgraduate level.
- 12.6 30% of the seats available in all the categories will be reserved for girl students.
- 12.7 12.8 Government of Madhya Pradesh, Department of Higher Education, Government Office/University, Commissioner, Office of Higher Education Regular/Retired/Date Officers and Employees, Principals, Professors, Librarians, Sports Officers, Registrars and Class III and IV working in Government Colleges Out of the available seats in all the concerned cadres, 5 percent of the seats will be reserved for the wards of the employees.
- 12.8 If a candidate of reserved category appears in the merit list in general category/open competition due to getting more marks, then the reserved category seats will remain unaffected. But if such a student belongs to any other cadre like freedom fighters etc., then the seat of the concerned cadre will be considered as filled in that particular reserved category. Remaining seats of the concerned specific cadre will be filled as per eligibility.

12.9 Admission in minority status colleges:

It will be mandatory for minority institutions to register on the portal of the Higher Education Department and in their institution, the information about the courses/subjects of the respective university, their seat number, fees etc. Will have to be entered on the portal and the verification of these courses is related. The mapping will have to be done by the college by the prescribed date.

There will be no restriction of reservation for SC/SC/OBC in minority institutions. Minority institutions will have to enter the information of the students admitted with them in the online module available on the portal on the dates fixed by the Higher Education Department. The last date fixed for reporting this process according to the online admission process table

12.9.1 Such non-government colleges which have the status of minority colleges, and want to apply for joining the offline admission process, then they will have to compulsorily

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submit the application along with the following documents to the Higher Education Department on the prescribed dates-

- By the government Updated NOC issued for the current session. (a)
- Updated affiliation certificate issued by the University for the current session. (b)
- Valid certificate of being a minority institution/college. (c)
- Certificate of the updated Governing Wadi/Management list registered in the (d) Registrar's Firm and Society office.
- Institution-wise aggregate information of minority category/non-minority category (e) students admitted in the previous year.
- Application of the institution to be exempted from the online admission process. (f)
- 12.9.2 While verifying the profile of the concerned minority college, the mapping colleges will match the original copies of 6 documents mentioned in 12.9.1 and upload them on the portal along with the signature and post currency of the verification officer.

It is the responsibility of the concerned university to re-verify the colleges added on the portal and it is mandatory for them to verify through the link given on the portal within the given time limit. The responsibility of conducting the above reverification will also be of the concerned college. If the time-limit is not re-verified by the university, then in this situation the said college will not be able to participate in the admission process.

- 12.10 If the percentage of reserved seats is less than half, then the reserved seats will not be available in the same category. Only if it falls between half to one percent, the number of reserved seats will be considered as one.
- 12.11 CLC as per clause 2.5 According to the time table in the phase, the reserved category vacancies as mentioned earlier will be available for the applicants of the unreserved (general) category.
- 12.12 Reservation rules issued by the government from time to time will be followed.
- 12.13 Courses whose ordinance mentions to be given through written examination: Eligible applicants will have to register on the portal and register their preference for the respective institution and course. The concerned institution will give admission according to the rules by conducting the entrance test of the registered applicants and will compulsorily enter the information of the admitted applicants on the portal.
